



Bible Prophecy Guide

The Elijah Message

Summary 17

Revelation 16:13 – We have looked at this false trinity in many presentations. We have seen how they work together in Revelation 13, 14, 16, & 17. This false trinity is composed of the dragon (Satan / Pagan Rome), beast (Roman Catholicism), & false prophet (apostate Protestantism)

1 King 16:30-33 – King Ahab & Queen Jezebel in an alliance lead Israel in false worship to Baal and the sun god.

1 Kings 21:8-10 – Jezebel used King Ahab's power & authority to carry out her sinister plans.

1 Kings 21:25 – Jezebel stirred up the King to do her will.

1 Kings 18:4, 13 – Jezebel killed the saints and was murderous.

2 Kings 9:22 – She is referred to as a Harlot, Mother, & Witch.

1 Kings 18:19 – The false prophets eat at Jezebel's table.

1 Kings 18:21 – Elijah is raised up to call the people to make a decision, to quit sitting on the fence. God's people were claiming to worship God while worshipping Baal.

1 Kings 19:10 – So called followers of God were seeking to destroy the covenant of God (so today folks say the law which is what God writes in our heart under the new covenant, they say has been done away with) and were seeking to destroy the prophets including Elijah.

1 Kings 18:30-31 – Elijah wasn't to create a new religion but call them back to the old one. God's remnant isn't a new church but is like the original. That's what remnant means. (See Rev. 12:17 KJV)

1 Kings 18:18 – The law was to be restored.

Elijah was seeking to restore true worship, God's holy law, and the gospel.

1 Kings 18:5 - Israel was struck with famine.

2 Chronicles 7:13-14 - God sent drought to invite them to repent.

1 Kings 18:17 – Elijah was seen as a trouble maker.

1 Kings 17:2-4 – Elijah, a true follower of God, was sustained in the wilderness. Remember, he fits the depiction of the remnant in Revelation 12 in that he kept the commandments and had the testimony of Jesus which is the Spirit of Prophecy according to Revelation 19:10.

1 Kings 18:26-29 – False worship was characterized as loud and raucous.

1 Kings 18:36-37 – Elijah's worship was simple and reverent.

1 Kings 18:38-39 The message from heaven brought conviction.

1 Kings 18:40 – The Israelites turned on the false prophets.

1 Kings 21:23-24 – The beasts & birds would consume the wicked that fell.

2 Kings 9:30-33 – She died and the horses were spattered by her blood. And notice that it was a king who had her destroyed.

2 Kings 9:7 – The judgment of the wicked was to avenge the blood of God's saints.

The Story of John the Baptist

Malachi 4:5-6 – God would send the spirit of prophecy before His coming to prepare the hearts of the people.

Matthew 3:4-6 – John the Baptist had a simple diet, dressed simply, and was to prepare the way of the 1st coming of Jesus.

Luke 1:16-17 – He was coming in the spirit and power of Elijah. He had an Elijah message.

Matthew 3:1-3 – His message was to repent which implies there needed to be a change of character.

John 1:29 – He was pointing people to the gospel, the lamb of God.

Mark 6:18 – He lifted up the law of God and wasn't afraid to call sin by its name even though it cost him his head.

Matthew 3:8, 10, 12 – John the Baptist shared a judgment message.

Mark 6:14-24 – Herod wasn't out to kill John the Baptist. The text says he sought to protect him for he feared him. But notice the striking parallels to the story of the end time:

1. John the Baptist appealed against fornication.
2. In the context of a party which no doubt involved wine, there was persecution.
3. John the Baptist had three enemies, King Herod, Herodias & Salome her daughter. So Elijah had three enemies, King Ahab, Jezebel, and the false prophets. Reminds us of Rev 16 & 17.

4. Notice that the queen used the power of the King and her daughter to carry out her malicious plot. So in the end, Papal Rome will use Apostate Protestantism and the United States to unite and carry out her malicious attack upon the righteous.

Revelation 16:19 – So these three divisions will work together in the end two persecute the saints. Revelation 6:13 identifies the three

Revelation 12:4b - Satan uses pagan Rome to carry out his evil.

Revelation 13:1-2 – Dragon who is Satan uses Rome to give its power and authority to the Papal church. The two were married if you will like Ahab & Jezebel and Herod and the queen.

Revelation 17:1, 5 – This beast power in Revelation 13:1-10 is also identified as a harlot. Both refer to the Papacy. The false prophets are the daughters of Babylon which is apostate Protestantism.

Revelation 18:23-24 - Babylon which entails the whore is guilty of witchcraft and murder like was Jezebel.

Revelation 14:6-12 – This is clearly the Elijah message for it has all the elements. It's a gospel message with a call to fear God and worship Him in the context of a judgment hour. There's a warning against fornication and to come out of false worship. There is a call to keep God's commandments and have the faith of Jesus.

Revelation 18:1-5 – The kings of the earth, that is the nations will fornicate with her. We see the flirting already between the papacy and the kings of the earth. Soon an image will be made and church and state will unite. The message of Elijah in these last days involves a call to come out of Babylon.

Revelation 12:17 – The war will escalate as we approach the end. But our call is not to take up arms but to use the sword of the Spirit demanding like Luther of old, a clear “Thus sayeth the Lord.”

Matthew 24:15 – God's people will have to flee like Elijah in the end.

Revelation 13:15 – We will face a death decree like both Elijah and John the Baptist.

Revelation 17:16-17 – So in the end, at the abomination of desolation as we studied on Sabbath, the wicked will turn on the Harlot and seek to destroy her.

Revelation 14:19-20 – Jesus will come but notice the blood on the horses bridle just as with Jezebel. But Jesus is the one who comes to take His people home according to Revelation 19.

Revelation 19:1-2 – God avenges the blood of His saints at the 2nd coming.

1 Kings 18:43-44 – God will come in the clouds of glory but the cloud will first be far off like the size of a man's hand. So it will be as we watch our redeemer return to take His saints home. Won't you stand for Jesus today and make your decision to follow Him in all His ways, allowing Him to write His law in your heart and seal you with His Holy Sabbath.
